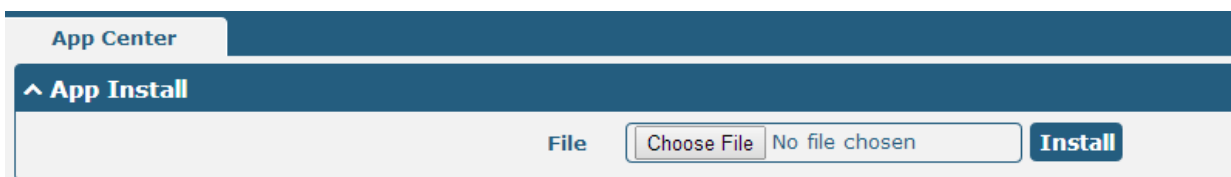

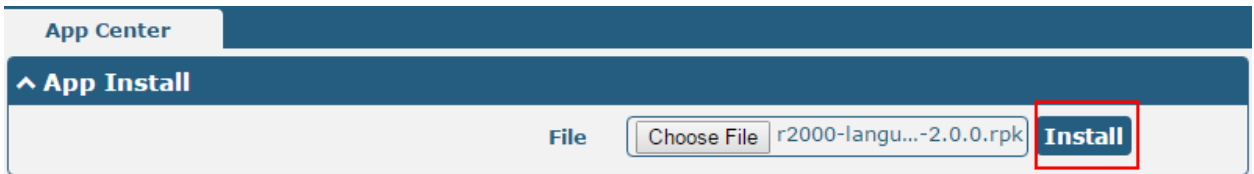
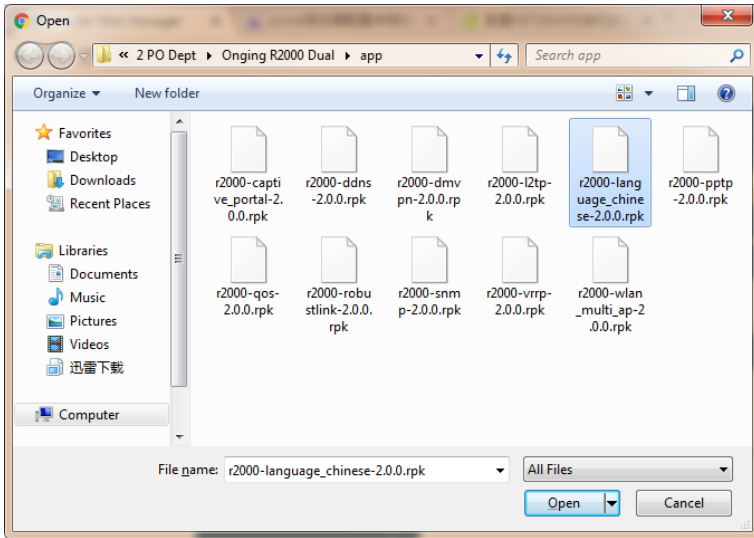
Here use Chinese language as an example to show the installation steps.

Path: **System->App**.

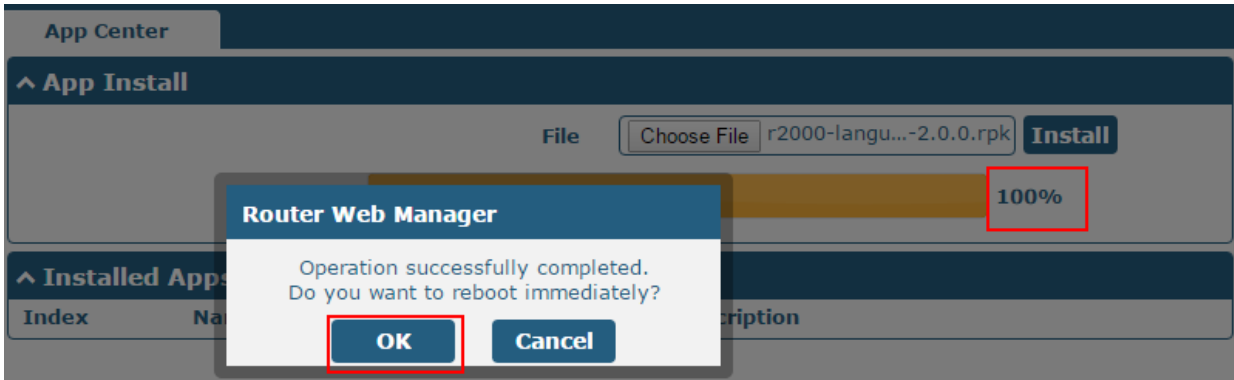
- 1 Please place Language App .rpk file (e.g. r2000-language-2.0.0.rpk) into a free disk of PC. And then log in router configuration page; go to **System->App** as the following screenshot show.



- Click “Choose File” button, select Language App .rpk file from the PC, then click “Install” button of router configuration page.

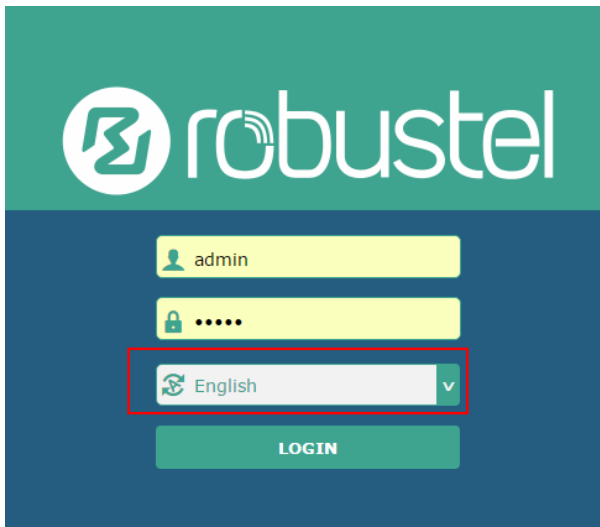


- When the rate of installation progress reach 100%, the system will pop up a reboot router reminder window. Please click “OK” to make router reboot.



Go to **System->App Center**, Chinese Language App will be included in App Center's "Installed Apps" list.

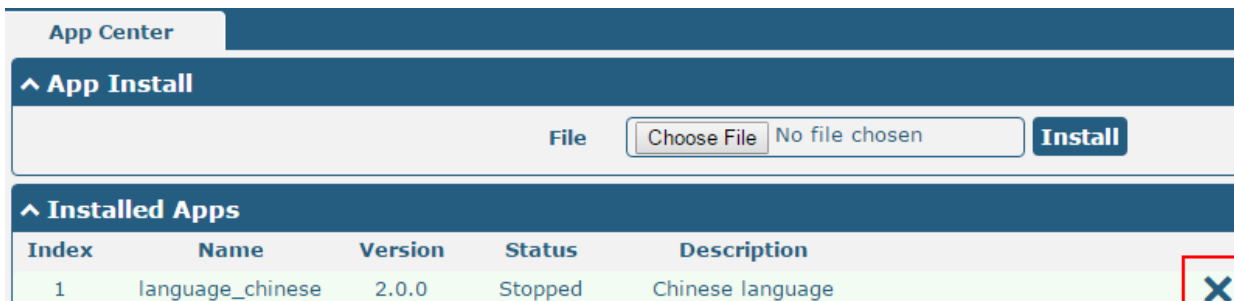
